
Knowing how to bounce back to move forward

2016 and 2017 have been non-stop.

Arndt Soret, Managing Director, suffered a serious accident when his bicycle was hit by a tram in Switzerland. He had to undergo a number of operations and four months of rehabilitation following several days in a coma. But that is all in the past and, fortunately, Humanium's Board was able to replace him successfully. But as far as coaching on the rights of the child are concerned, Humanium had lost its figurehead.

Since Arndt's return, the Humanium team has been more committed and innovative than ever. "When I woke up from the coma, my first thought was whether I had ever done anything good in my life, that was the co-creation of Humanium. We must continue with our coaching approach so that children and adults working with children can connect with their inner strength. That's how they can make their dreams come true and work together to make our magnificent planet an ever more beautiful place, in the South and in the North," he says.

In the next ten years, Humanium will work with more and more leaders, coaching them to develop new tools and ensuring that countries ranked "black" are transformed, with your support.



Challenges

A year rich in learning

Arndt Soret's accident led to a sharp fall in fundraising activities in 2017 with a slump lasting almost six months. This had a knock-on effect on the ground, meaning that projects planned for 2016-2017 were not able to start until the second quarter of 2017.

In parallel, faced with several applications, Humanium's Board decided to approve the recruitment of a Head of Development (60 percent of full time). When Emilie Compignie took up her post at the end of May 2017, fundraising activities were able to get going again. This significant step, which does have repercussions for the accounts and income statement for 2017, was nevertheless necessary.

In its nine years, the Humanium team, mainly volunteers, has had to overcome many challenges to make the rights of the child a reality worldwide. Today, the NGO has reached a turning point in its history: professionalizing its structure so it can continue to develop and work online and on the ground. To this end, the team is working to connect with dedicated donors, ready to support a bold organization to improve the lives of children worldwide.

in order to eventually integrate them back in the state school system in order to eventually integrate them back in the state school system in the traditional school system. Activities started with our local partner, Hand in Hand India, in summer 2017.

In the first four months we were able to carry out a preliminary survey on the ground of grasping an understanding of the challenge faced by the population and identify the children in need of our support. 106 children were identified as having left school to work or dropped out for long periods. There were able to receive support through the non-residential rehabilitation centre for an initial period.

The survey also facilitated an awareness-raising campaign aimed at parents and community mobilization activities on the importance of education. By organizing 218 events and meetings with different groups from the village, we were able to motivate 455 children to return to school, including 356 who returned to complete secondary school.

7158 people from the village benefited from these events: parents, women, teenagers, youth clubs, schools and development councils.

While awaiting government authorizations to move to the residential model, three non-residential rehabilitation centres were already in operation for the 106 children in the most precarious situations.







Transforming Perumbakkam into a child-friendly village

Together with our partner, Hand in Hand India, we wanted to transform the village of Perumbakkam, in the south of India, into a child-friendly village. To this end, we worked with the whole community to create a health environment conducive to the children's physical, mental and intellectual development.

Using a holistic approach, our activities target children directly. On the one hand, guaranteeing access to education and healthcare, and running awareness-raising campaigns on the rights of the child and on the other hand, we sought to promote sustainable development and create decent living conditions for the whole community so that it would have the means to support its children.

To this end, we focused on empowerment and training programmes for women, micro-credit and business development activities, the creation of ecological and innovative farms and even the installation of drinking water facilities.

We launched the project in December 2017 with a field survey and an awareness-raising campaign on health agriculture. To date, 100 ecological farms have been established in Perumbakkam and the surrounding area.



In February 2018, Arndt Soret, Humanium CEO, joined by a professional coach, was on the ground to launch the training and coaching activities. In one week, 80 children and 200 school teachers and social assistants were trained on our defending the rights of the child programme.

Rwanda

Improve the rights of the child and stop domestic violence

23 years after the genocide, **Rwandan family life is being rebuilt.** However, the traumatic experiences lived by these children now turned parents are profound and their recovery rests on fragile foundations. Through its innovative workshops, Humanium trains its local partners to promote social healing and raises the population's awareness of the rights of the child.

The initial months were dedicated to **analysing the social context of the areas of intervention**, in particular discovering the violence suffered and identifiing the community leaders, to act as local champions of the values to be communicated. The tools and techniques used in the workshops aim to ensure **intuitive understanding of the rights of the child.**

Based on **five stages** - emotional connection, sharing, role play, group discussion and integration - each session is different and adapted to the needs of the beneficiaries. The eight fundamental rights of the child are ever present.

The workshops, which have already brought together more than 1100 leaders, attract a variety of participants. Parents, children and even teachers, all demonstrate a true desire for change. The project aims to improve how it monitors the groups already reached in order to encourage greater community initiative with the goal of instilling reflexes in both children and adults, to promote community resilience, reduce domestic violence and improve the mental health of the population.

Our Partners

India



Since 2004, Hand in Hand India has been fighting poverty in 13 states across India and beyond, through job creation and integrated community programmes. Their work is based on five pillars: empowerment of women, health, environment, vocational and technical training, and ending child labour and education.

It is this last pillar where Humanium offers its expertise and know-how. As such, we are working on the roots of poverty. In the nine years of our partnership, nine projects have already been successfully implemented. The most recent "Transforming Perumbakkam into a child-friendly village" represents another step forward with the integration of coaching workshops on the rights of the child.

Financial report

Overview of our 2017 financial report

Despite an important slowdown in our fundraising activities during the first semester 2017, Humanium has managed to maintain its budget and its level of activities, thus proving its high adaptability and resilience.

The increase in employment costs can be explained by the hiring of the first Development Officer, which was necessary to keep our association afloat after this difficult period.

The prospects for new sources of funding in 2018 should allow us to balance the budget again. Originally, Humanium has always had very little administrative and running costs thanks to our working platform online.

In the field, our projects did not suffer from these fluctuations and their implementation is taking place as planned.

Last but not least, the goal for the next three years is to structure Humanium around a small professional team in order to better answer the many requests we face but also to keep on developing our activities.
